	Participate in an open program at one of the camp program areas.
	Help a Scout in your troop meet a rank advancement requirement.
	Do <b>one</b> of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Shoot a quarter-sized five-round grouping at the rifle range.</li> <li>• Shoot a score of 20 at the archery range.</li> <li>• Complete an art project at handicraft.</li> <li>• Participate in open swim or boat.</li> <li>• Attend the star party at Eco-STEM.</li> </ul>

The Brownsea Island Scout Camp was the site of a boys’ camping event on Brownsea Island in Poole Harbour, southern England, organized by Lieutenant-General Baden-Powell to test his ideas for the boy *Scouting for Boys*. Boys from different social backgrounds participated from August 1 to 8, 1907 in activities around camping, observation, woodcraft, chivalry, lifesaving, and patriotism. The event is regarded as the origin of the worldwide Scout movement.
