EARN THIS PATCH FOR THE DISTRICT COMMITTEE!

The District Achievement Award is presented annually to registered district committee members that demonstrate outstanding growth, engagement, and commitment to Scouting values. This award recognizes districts that excel in membership growth, program participation, and fundraising efforts, ensuring a thriving and sustainable Scouting program for all youth.

Award Criteria

To earn the District Achievement Award, a district must meet all the following benchmarks:

1. Membership Growth

- By December 15, 2025, achieve growth in overall membership, including a positive increase in Cub Scouting enrollment.

2. Unit Growth

- By December 15, 2025, achieve year-end growth in total Scouting units, including an increase in Cub Scout Packs within the district.

3. Outdoors

- Demonstrate an increase in overall Laurel Highlands camping participation by August 15, 2025 to include Cub Scout Day Camps, Cub Scout Resident Camp (Camp Independence), Boy Scout Resident Camp (Camp Freedom, Camp Liberty, Scouts@Work and Squatch Camp).

4. Popcorn Sale

- Have a growth of 5.27% by October 31, 2025 in Sales with a net plus in number of units participating in the sale.

5. Scouting 365

- Have at least 80% of registered District Committee members attend one of three scheduled Scouting 365 informational webinars (September, October, November)

Districts that successfully meet all criteria will be recognized with:

- The Scouting District Achievement Award patch for each District Committee Member
- Formal recognition at the Council Annual Meeting
- Recognition for District Leadership at a Council Recognition Event.

This award serves as a testament to the dedication, leadership, and commitment of the district's volunteers, unit leaders, and Scouts in fostering a thriving and sustainable Scouting community.
