



## 2025 LHC Unit Achievement Award

### ***EARN THIS PATCH FOR EVERYONE IN YOUR UNIT!***

The Unit Achievement Award is presented annually to Packs and Troops that demonstrate outstanding growth, program engagement, and financial sustainability. This award recognizes units that excel in membership growth, camping participation, and fundraising efforts, ensuring a thriving and sustainable Scouting experience for all youth.

#### **Award Criteria**

To earn the Scouting Unit Achievement Award patch for everyone registered in your unit, a Pack or Troop must meet all the following benchmarks:

##### **1. Membership**

- Have more youth members registered in your unit October 31, 2025, compared to October 31, 2024

##### **2. Unit Charter**

- Renew your Units Charter by November 30, 2025

##### **3. Outdoors**

- Participate in a unit coordinated Laurel Highlands Council summer program by August 15, 2025, to include:
  - Cub Scout Packs: Camp Independence Resident Camp and/or Cub Scout Day Camp.
  - Scouts BSA Troops attend one or more of the following: Heritage Reservation Camp Freedom, Heritage Reservation Camp Liberty, Scouts@Work (Camp Potomac), Squatch Camp (Camp Seph Mack)

##### **4. Popcorn Sale**

- Coordinate and Execute 1 Show & Sell for your Pack or Troop by October 15, 2025.

##### **5. Scouting 365**

- Have at least 3 volunteers register and attend one of three scheduled Scouting 365 informational webinars (September, October, November)

Units that successfully meet all criteria will receive:

- *The Scouting Unit Achievement patch*
- Recognition at the Council Annual Meeting and District Roundtable
- Special recognition for unit leaders at a Council Recognition Event.
